Rider Status Definitions

- Junior refer to riders 17 years old and younger.
- Adults refer to riders 18 years old and older.
- Adult Professional means a rider who is no longer a junior but does accept sponsorship or monetary gains from his/her riding.
- Adult Amateur means a rider who is no longer a junior and does not accept sponsorship or monetary gains from his/her riding.
- No Rider protections are available unless ShowPlus benefits are available for the horse. See Benefit Schedule for Horses.
- A rider's protections are contingent upon riding a horse registered to compete for that week and last for the duration of the rider's competition(s) that week.
- All requests will be denied if not submitted within five days from the date of the incident.

Benefit Schedule for Horses

Mortality

C\$25,000

Maximum potential mortality payment, supplemental to any existing mortality policy, but not to exceed the actual amount of the loss.

Urgent Veterinary Care

C\$2,500

Maximum urgent veterinarian care for each horse, with a scale based on the type of injury or illness.

Covered Conditions

Colic - Non Surgical	C\$750
Colic - Surgical	C\$2,500
Broken Bones	C\$2,500
Upper Respiratory Infection or Pneumonia*	C\$500
Deep Laceration or Puncture Wound	C\$1,000
Heat Stroke	C\$500

Diagnostics that are medically necessary as part of immediate care. Reduced to 30% if injury / illness determined to be pre-existing or chronic. Bone scan, MRI & CT scan: Pre-approval required

Consequential Cost

Up to C\$2,500

Specialty Transportation

Benefits are available only to registered horses. Protections under ShowPlus® are provided on a weekly basis.

Protections expire at the end of each week for horses stabled on site.

For animals stabled off-site, protections begin one hour before the scheduled ride time and end one hour after the class is finished on show days.

All requests will be denied if not submitted within five days from the date of the incident.

No Benefits

*at all afforded on Mondays, or "dark days".

*for accidents or injuries in a paddock or due to turnout.

*as the result of failure to provide appropriate care or neglect of any animal.

*if the incident is not reported per the instructions on the website.

*for treatments normally associated with the maintenance of a healthy animal.

*for pre-existing or chronic conditions other than for bone scans, MRI, or CT Scan, which are subject to limitations. *for experimental or voluntary surgery or procedure of any type.

*for any medical treatment or disease control measures associated with any communicable/contagious disease outbreak.

*for any horse younger than 4 years old and older than 16 years old unless the event is sanctioned by the FEI. (CDI-CSI shows)

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
