- Consequential reimbursement for stitching is available when a rider is not eligible for other rider benefits; if the rider is eligible for reimbursement for other rider benefits, the

reimbursement limit for stitching is included in the other benefit limit.

- All requests will be denied if not submitted within seven days from the date of the incident.
